- ◇ Warm, waterproof jacket
- ◇ Clothing for the week (prepare for possible rain and colder temps)
- ◇ Gloves, warm hat, scarf (temperatures are unpredictable this time of year)
- ◇ Comfortable shoes for walking
- ◇ Work clothes and gloves; shoes for work
- ◇ Backpack/day bag

- ◇ Toiletries: toothbrush & toothpaste, shower gel/soap, shampoo, deodorant, any other toiletries needed

Day 1: Friday, 3/27 - Arrival

- Afternoon arrival

Day 2: Saturday, 3/28 – Prayer Tour - Outreach

- Afternoon: Youth Sport Outreach
- Evening: Youth night with local young people

Day 3: Sunday, 3/29 – Church Service

- Morning: church visits (share testimonies and sing in each church)
- Afternoon: training - creative evangelism
- Evening: worship – free time

Day 4: Monday, 3/30 – Practical work

- Morning: devotional DBS then practical work
- Afternoon: practical work
- Evening: free time

Day 5: Tuesday, 3/31 – Outing

- Day off - explore the city of Turin
- Evening: free time – games

Day 6: Wednesday, 4/1 – Outreach

- Morning: devotional DBS then schools cultural program
- Afternoon: nursing homes – programs
- Evening: worship – testimonies - debriefing

LODGING INFO

They will be staying in a Christian center in Bobbio Pellice, in the region of Piemonte. Bobbio Pellice is a commune (municipality) located about 50 kilometers (31 mi) southwest of Turin, on the border with France and at the end of the Val Pellice.

All girls will be separated from boys, with adults in separate rooms, however all students and adults will be in the same building. All beds, bedding and towels will be provided. Please see packing list.

Meals (three per day) will be prepared by the center's staff members. Breakfast is usually light, with cooked meals for lunch and dinner. On the off day, team members can eat in Turin at their own expense.
