PACKING LIST

- ◇ Money: Spain uses the Euro. ATMs are available. If using credit cards, pay in Euros as it is cheaper.
- ◇ Bedding is provided. Bring your own towel/washcloth if possible, but some are available.
- ◇ WiFi available. Check your phone carrier for data roaming rates. Turn off mobile data if too expensive.
- ◇ Bible/App
- ◇ Medications
- ◇ Toiletries (including sunscreen if needed)
- ◇ Clothes: In March, temperatures are typically 60–70°F. Washer and dryer available. Churches are casual (jeans and nice shirt)
- ◇ Light jacket (preferably rain resistant)
- ◇ Work clothes
- ◇ Swimsuit (swimming in the ocean will be cold!)
- ◇ Comfortable shoes (maybe also sandals/flip flops)
- ◇ Good, broken in, walking/hiking shoes, especially for walking the Camino.
- ◇ Backpack/day bag
- ◇ Extra spending money for personal items, souvenirs and optional sightseeing
- ◇ Charging cables (with US to European adapters)



Though rich in history and beauty, Spain is spiritually dry, especially along the Camino de Santiago, where thousands of pilgrims walk seeking meaning but rarely encounter the Gospel. This mission invites you to be a light in that spiritual desert, offering rest, hope and truth to weary travelers. Through hands-on outreach, youth engagement and practical service, you'll help plant seeds of faith in a country where evangelical presence is still small. If you're drawn to relational ministry, cultural immersion and sharing Jesus in creative ways, Spain is calling.
